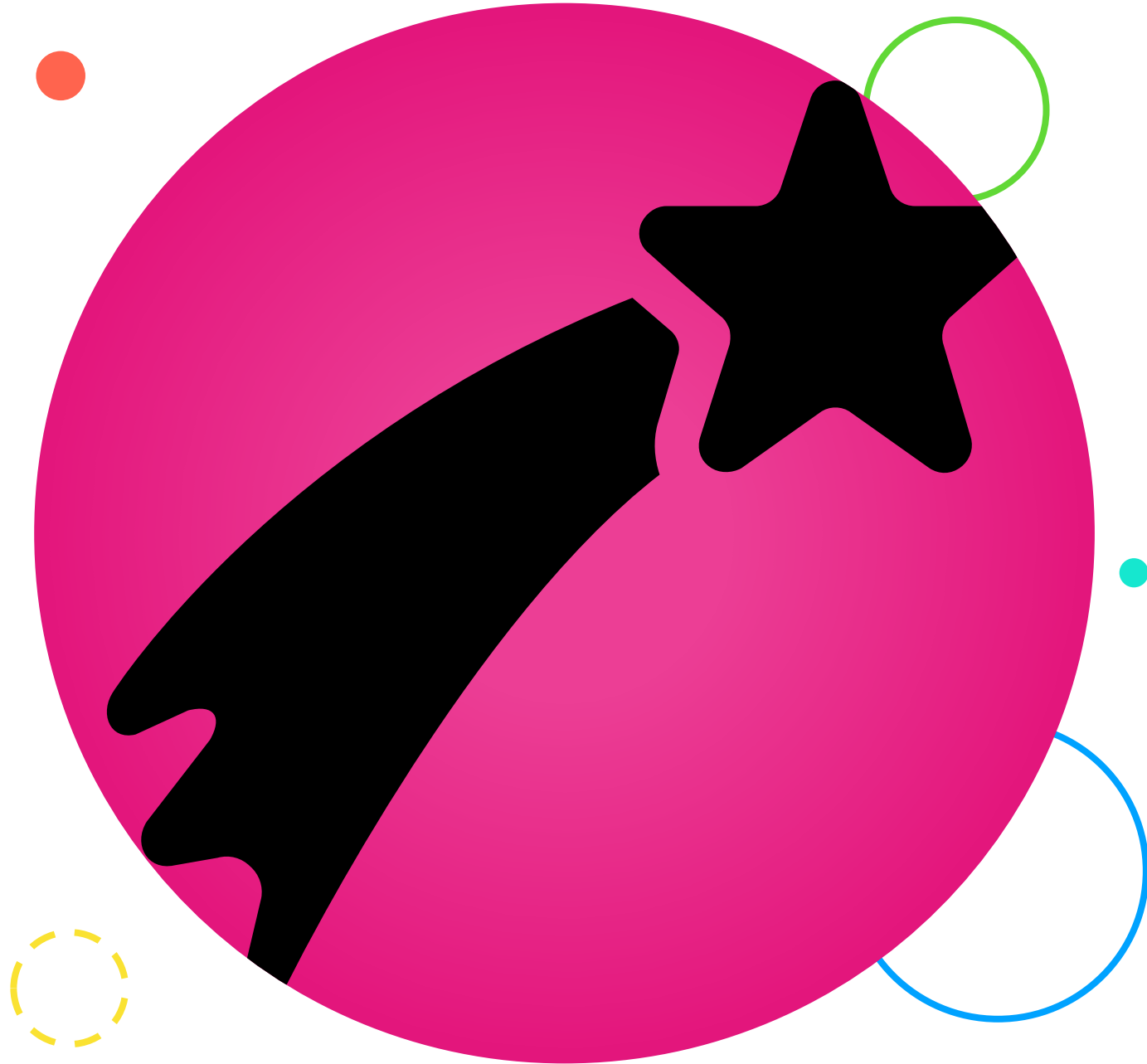
Getting our EDI Action Plan approved and starting to map base line and deliver on objectives.

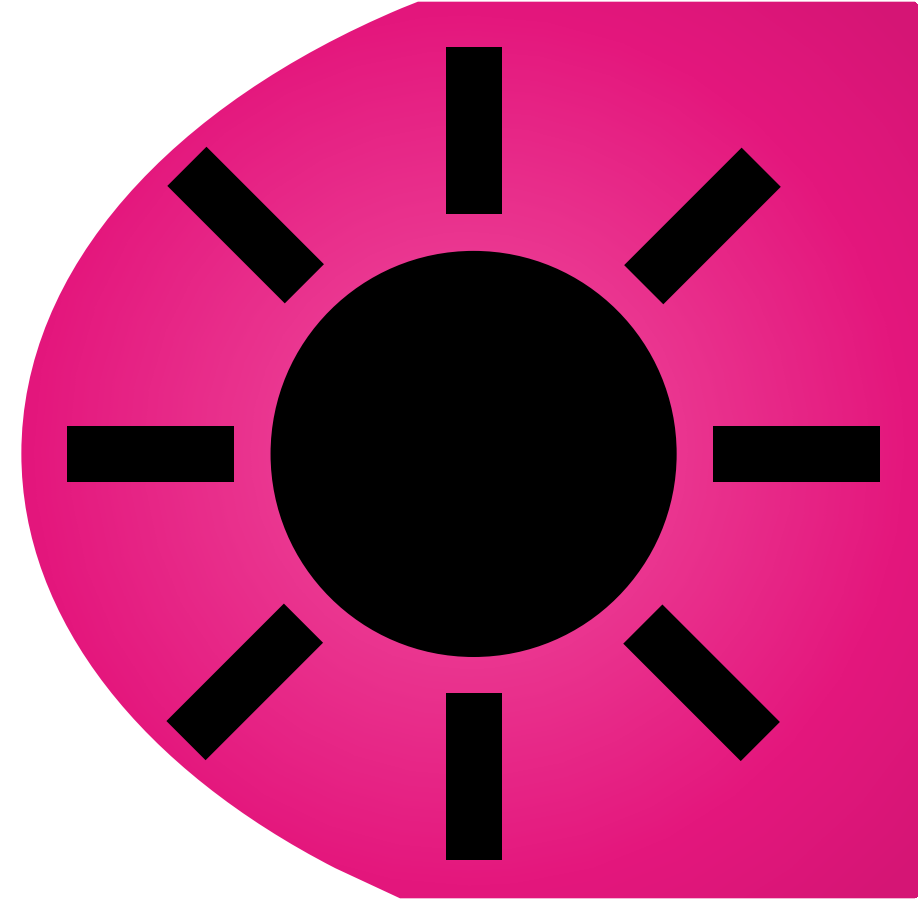






FREEDOM OF SPEECH CODE

- We will be working with the Respect Group to plan further actions to support this (i.e. through discussion events like the Teaching and Learning Conference)

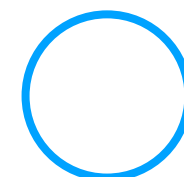
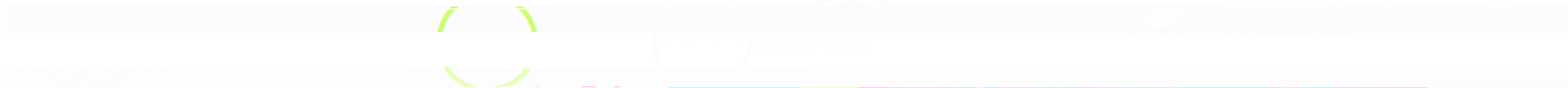




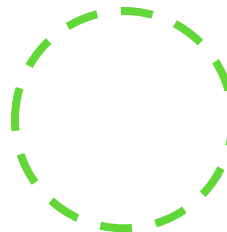
